

Admissions Policy

Statement of intent

It is Trull Saplings Preschools intention to make our setting accessible to children and families from all sections of the local community.

Aim

Trull Saplings Preschool aim to ensure that all sections of our community have access to the setting through open, fair and clearly communicated procedures.

Methods

In order to achieve this aim, we operate the following admissions procedure:

- We accept 2 year old to school age children.
- We only accept children who will be attending 1 setting, this means we cannot accept a child who will be requiring to attend another setting - Nursery, Preschool or childminders – this has been implemented during the COVID-19 pandemic to ensure the safety of children and Preschool team members. This will be monitored throughout the term by complying with Government guidance and through communicating with other Early Years Providers within the Taunton area.
- We ensure that the existence of our setting is widely advertised in places accessible to all sections of the community.
- We ensure that information about our setting is accessible, in written and spoken form and, where appropriate, in more than one language. Where necessary, we will try to provide information in Braille, or through signing or an interpreter.
- We arrange our waiting list in birth order.
- We keep a place vacant, if this is financially viable, to accommodate an emergency admission.
- We describe our setting and its practices in terms that make it clear that it welcomes fathers and mothers, other relations and other carers, including childminders.
- We describe our setting and its practices in terms of how it treats each child and their family, having regard to their needs arising from their gender, special educational needs, disabilities, social background, religion, and ethnicity or from English being a newly acquired additional language.
- We describe our setting and its practices in terms of how it enables children and/or parents with disabilities to take part in the life of the setting.
- We monitor the gender and ethnic background of children joining the group to ensure that our intake is representative of social diversity.
- We make valuing diversity and promoting equality policy widely known.
- We are flexible about attendance patterns to accommodate the needs of individual children and families, providing these do not disrupt the pattern of continuity in the setting that provides stability for all of the children.
